

**SAN DIEGO PRESBYTERY
DISASTER ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE**

CRITERIA FOR FUNDING

The following criteria serve as a guideline for the SD Presbytery Disaster Assistance Committee in reviewing requests from a church of the Presbytery for a project for which they are requesting funding assistance.

- Projects funded should be directly related to a loss from the designated disaster
- Funding should be focused on goods and services provided per plans generated by individuals qualified for that type relief
- Funding would be for projects that are larger than an individual church's resources permit
- Assistance would be limited to individuals who are included in the regional case management system (e.g., Regional Community Recovery Team case workers; data entered into the Coordinated Assistance Network {CAN})
- Assistance could be provided to businesses that are (or whose owners are) included in the regional recovery management system.
- Assistance for each individual case would be within the designated dollar limit determined by the Presbytery's Disaster Assistance Committee for that disaster
