Executive Director Report September 2023

Vision: We are spiritual, missional, and relational leaders assisting and supporting congregations to become communities of faith, hope, love, and witness.

Mission: We move toward our Vision by *Planting* churches, *Vitalizing* churches, *Discerning* with churches, and *Aligning* our polity to be more mission focused.

In the past three months:

- Met, prayer for, and engaged with pastors, elders, and sessions in the presbytery.
- Preached at Chula Vista, Fletcher Hills, Faith Presbyterian, Mt. Soledad Presbyterian, Trinity Presbyterian, Northminster.
- Finished Review of Cyclical SD, incorporated those recommendations into a larger recommendation from the Advisory Cabinet that is available on the Presbytery Website and will be discussed at Presbytery.
- Working with Committees in making changes to Presbytery structure and Manual of Operations.
- Met with other Executive Presbyters in our Synod.
- Attended presbytery committee meetings as ex-officio (CPM, COM, BPF, HR, Executive Council, Nominations, New Day Steering Committee, Real Estate Task Force, Cyclical SD, and DCV).
- Invited and accepted to serve on the Task Force for Ordination Standards for the PCUSA General Assembly.
- Met with the leadership at Inglesia Presbyteriana Emmanuel and held town hall style meeting.
- Continued discussions on financial income for Southeastern, Inglesia Presbyteriana Emmanuel, and Orange Ave.
- Began discussions with the Real Estate Task Force with organizations that deal with affordable housing.
- Began having discussions with Young Nak which is nested on the Linda Vista property about being a chartered PCUSA congregation.
- Worked on an in-depth process bringing a NWC from development through chartering. This handbook will now get the input from committees.
- Hosted "Church Safety and Security" Training led by Presbyterian Disaster Assistance at Mira Mesa Presbyterian.
- Worked on a "Discerning a Churches Future" handbook to help churches develop a vision. This handbook will now get input from committees.
- Attended "Day of Learning" on stewardship with the Presbyterian Foundation.
- Wrote and submitted a grant to the Lily Foundation on Church Vitalization in partnership with the Riverside Presbytery and Santa Barbara Presbytery for \$1.25 million over 5 years. Awarding will be this fall.

• Began forming two task forces and two ad hock task forces in consultation with Chair of Council, Moderator, and Moderator-elect.
